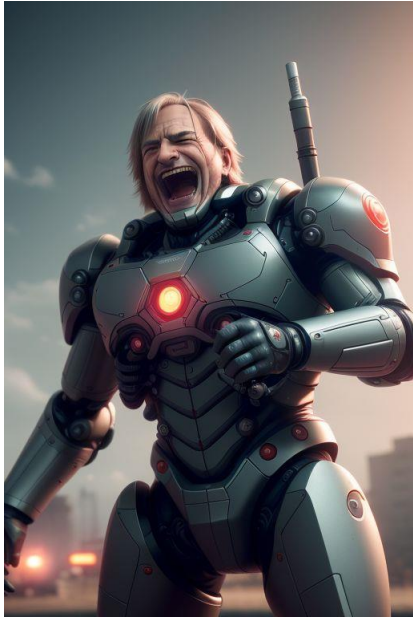
Beware of the Bludger Curse!
